The Rodens have certainly made an impact on their community throughout their lives. Both were born and raised in Grandview, and the couple will celebrate six decades of marriage on June 2. They began volunteering through the Grandview Senior Citizens Center in Grandview in 1982, and continue to serve as Meals-on-Wheels volunteers today.
